The Journal AFRICA Announces Special Discount Rate

Africa, the Journal of the International African Institute, has launched a discounted subscription rate for new subscribers.

From 2006, first-time subscribers can get 4 issues per year at the special reduced rate of £40/\$72 – a saving of over 20% on the normal rate.

Africa is the premier journal devoted to the study of African societies and culture. Editorial policy encourages an interdisciplinary approach, involving the social sciences, history, the environment and life sciences.

Each issue contains five or six major articles, arranged thematically, extensive review essays and substantial book reviews.

The first issue of the 2006 volume is a special issue, entitled **African Socialisms and Postsocialisms**. Edited by Anne Pitcher and Kelly Askew, the issue will also be published as a book with a different cover from the standard issue sent to subscribers. This means that, for the first time, issues of **Africa** will also be available to non-subscribers through book shops. **African Socialisms and Postsocialisms** (**Africa** 76.1) will be available in February with a cover price of £16.99. ISBN is 0-7486-2483-X. Plans are also underway to publish both **Africa** 74.1 (2004) and **Africa** 75.1 (2005) as books.
